Seminar 3: by **Dr. Belinda Karge** on - "Student Engagement Techniques."

Seminar 4: by **Dr. Catherine Webb** – on "Getting to Know Your Students."

In particular, we were blessed to listen/observe and participate in the application of research-based teaching techniques focused on student centeredness. -> English Language Support Program (ELSP)... As a follow up to the June 2023 faculty development seminars conducted in the area of "Sheltered Instruction", in October 2023, the MCN team led by Dr. Vicki Anderson, Professor at Concordia University Nebraska, and Mission of Christ Network Partner, had a very productive time assessing the impact and level of application on materials and techniques presented in June. During the three day assessment workshops the MCN team, composed of Vicki Anderson, Ph.D. Professor at Concordia University Nebraska and MCN Partner, Cindy Rodewald, Director for Mission Care and MCN field lead for East Africa and Haragewen Abraham Kinde, Ed.D., MYS Vice President of International Relations and MCN team member, met with representatives from the College of Theological Studies, Mekane Yesus Management and Leadership Colleges Addis Ababa and Bishoftu campuses, and School of Music and Media respectively.



Furthermore, discussion on feasibility of a **one-year intensive English program** to be piloted through the College of Theological Studies were successfully conducted.
