Dr. Zimmerman will lead us in considering three categories of wellness:

- 2. Life in Community (relational, intellectual and emotional wellness)
- 3. Life in Ministry (vocational, physical, and financial wellness)

He will teach a simple biblical model for selfassessment and the beginning steps for addressing personal wellness needs.
