- + Panama City is the only capital city in the world that has a rain forest in its city limits.

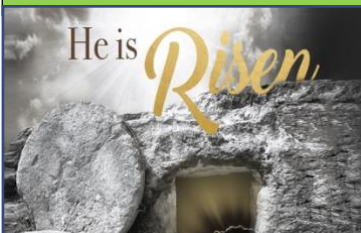
AN UPDATE ON THE CONRADs

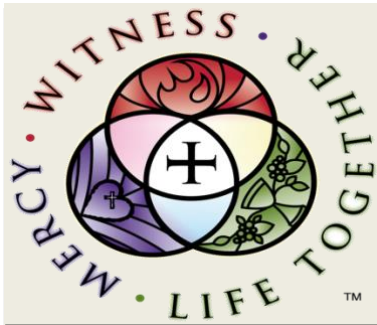

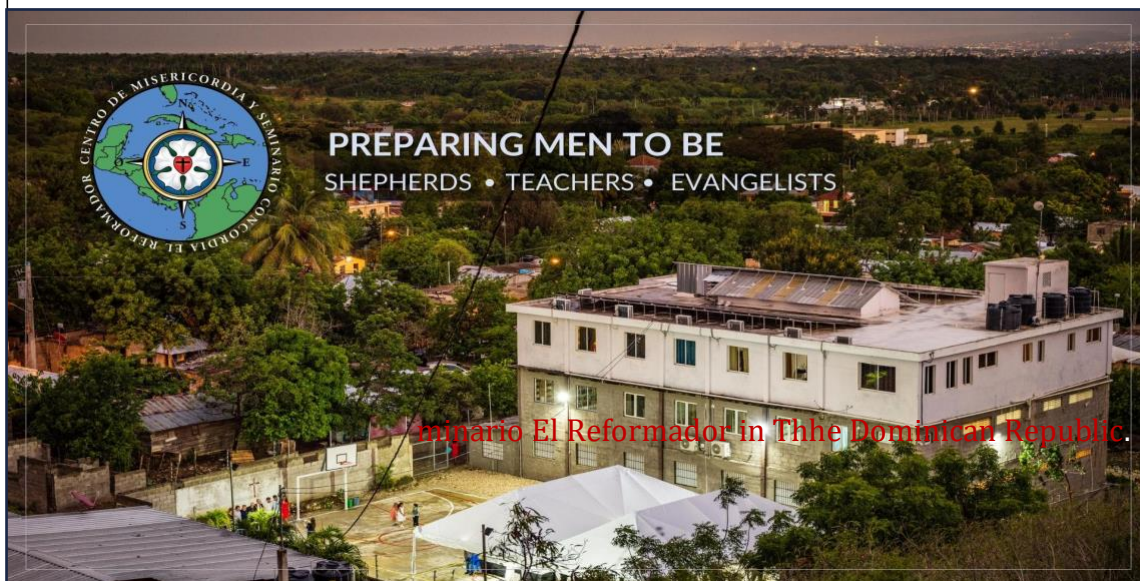
