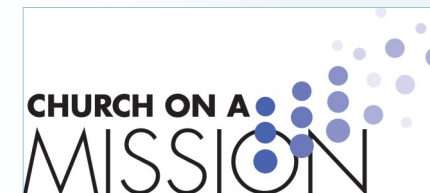

New Church Plants

Addis Kidan (New Covenant), San Francisco

– This primarily Ethiopian congregation was founded in late 2015 with Tesfai Tesema as missionary leader. Since that time, they have expanded into an English-language neighborhood ministry and 2nd generation work. They are blessed with the assistance of CMC Irvine Vicar Muluneh Teye and lay leader, Joseph Ruiz.



Faith Lutheran in South San Francisco, (1st and 2nd Generation Cantonese)

– This recently organized congregation operates out of South San Francisco and reaches into the Cantonese

speaking community with intentional targeted outreach. The ministry was founded in June 2014, and has been successful reaching back into the first generation from their children.

San Juan Valle de Fe, (St. John's Valley of Faith) in Arvin, CA

(1st and 2nd generation Latino, and English speaking) – This congregation is a satellite of St. John's in Bakersfield. San Juan looks forward to its next missionary leader. They are served presently with lay leadership, Marvin St. Pierre and Jorge Aguilera.



Good Shepherd in Hayward (Replant)

– This congregation, under Pastor Dawit Bokre, merges the replant of their English language group around millennial leadership and their strong Eritrean worshipping congregation. Pastor

Dawit receives assistance from EIIT Vicar Paul Lauaki, School of Young Leaders Director and future church planter.
